## Playing with the Tangram Puzzle

There are two ways to play with tangrams. One way is to try to duplicate shapes from a simple outline of the shape. Another way uses your imagination and sense of fun to create new designs. The most common designs are silhouettes of animals, people, and objects. A mathematician has calculated that there are at least 1600 designs that can be made with the seven tangram pieces/tans. Use more than one puzzle set, and the possibilities grow even larger. How many designs can you create?

When playing with tangrams, keep these simple rules in mind: All seven tans are used in each picture (except where noted). All tans remain flat, none standing.
Each tan may touch another, but none may overlap.
